Thanks to grant funding, the **Battle Creek Fire Department** can provide a limited quantity of programmable home alert systems and bed shaking devices, installed by the fire department at no cost.



These home alert systems use various methods to effectively alert individuals with hearing impairments to active smoke and carbon monoxide alarms.

To be eligible, **households must be located within the city limits of Battle Creek**. Quantities are limited, and devices will be made available on a first come, first served basis.
