



CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Authorization:

State Act #78 of 1935, was adopted by the voters on November 6, 1962.

Appointing Authority:

Section 2 of Act 78 of 1935 (MCL 38.502).

- One (1) member appointed by the Mayor with City Commission approval.
- One (1) member elected by the paid members of the City Fire Department.
- One (1) member selected by the above two (2) members.

Purpose:

To establish and provide a board of civil service commissioners for the City's Fire Department, who provide a civil service system based upon examination and investigation as to merit, efficiency, and fitness for appointment, employment, and promotion of all full-time paid members appointed in the City's fire department. They also regulate the transfer, reinstatement, suspension, and discharge of fire fighters and prescribe penalties and provide remedies.

Membership:

Three (3) members.

Term:

Six years.

Special Requirements:

City resident for one (1) year;
County resident for three (3) years;
Hold no other government office;
No more than two of the same political party.

Compensation:

None.

Monthly and/or As Needed.
