



HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

Authorization:

Public Act 169 of 1970 of the State of Michigan provided for the establishment of a Historic District Study Commission; and, further, Ordinance No. 22-81, adopted October 6, 1981, allowed for the establishment of a Historic District Commission to implement said Ordinance.

Seven (7) members who shall reside in the City, one of whom shall be a graduate of an accredited school of architecture, have two years of architectural experience, or an architect registered in the state, if available.

The bylaws and authorizing State Statute provides that the Mayor shall appoint at least two (2) members from a list of citizens submitted by one or more duly organized local historic preservation organizations.

Term:

Three-year terms.

Special Requirement:

Members are limited to two consecutive terms by ordinance and the bylaws.

Compensation:

None.
